He will likely [= probably] be late. It will likely rain tomorrow. This use of likely has sometimes been criticized, but it is very common. It does not occur in highly formal writing.

While solar panels need sunlight to generate electricity, heat itself doesn't improve performance. In fact, the hotter panels become, the more their efficiency drops.

In conversation and in informal writing, likely is sometimes an adverb with most, more than, or very in front of it, or as part of the phrase more likely than not.

Solar panels are generally tested at 25°C (77°F) to evaluate their efficiency. During operation, the temperature of solar panels usually ranges between 15°C and 35°C under normal ...
