Does Rwanda have a telecommunications infrastructure?

Rwanda also has access to 2.5Gbps international capacity through the SEACOM and TEAMS submarine cables. In addition to government-funded infrastructure, private sector operators have contributed significantly to the development of telecommunications infrastructure nationwide.

Can I listen to Rwanda's radio stations online?

Most radio stations in Rwanda are accessible online, either through their own websites and blogs, or through social media.

Which agencies supervise telecommunications in Rwanda?

Two government-appointed regulatory bodies, the Rwanda Information Technology Authority under the Rwanda Development Board, and the Rwanda Utilities Regulatory Agency (RURA), supervise the regulatory frameworks and implementation of the country's policies and strategies in the telecommunications sector.
