The IFC is finalizing a loan to Benin Terminal -- a subsidiary of French group Africa Global Logistics (AGL) -- to upgrade the Container Terminal at the seaport of Cotonou.

The project is a brownfield upgrade of the existing container terminal / logistics zone from its current 32.6ha to 44.7 ha, with BT representing 23% of the total Port area (193 ha).
